Day 1: Friday, July 30, 2027 Toronto, Ontario Arrive in cosmopolitan Toronto, capital of Ontario and Canada's largest city. As many flights arrive in the late afternoon and evening, your only scheduled activity is a welcome briefing tonight. Afterwards, take time to settle in or check out a local restaurant for dinner on your own.

Day 2: Saturday, July 31, 2027 Toronto - Niagara Falls - Toronto This morning, travel to Niagara Falls, home to the awe-inspiring set of waterfalls nestled along the border between the United States and Canada. Embark on a boat cruise to the base of the falls and witness the thundering water from up close. Continue on to Niagara-on-the-Lake and take advantage of some free time to discover the "loveliest town in Canada." Get a glimpse into the region's 300-year-old winemaking history with a welcome lunch at a local winery. (B, L)

Day 3: Sunday, August 1, 2027 Toronto - Rockport - Ottawa This morning, prepare for a long driving day, taking in the surrounding landscape of Ontario as you travel to Rockport, gateway to the spectacular Thousand Islands. Enjoy a memorable cruise through this unspoiled region, located along the St. Lawrence River. Then, set off for Ottawa, Canada's capital city, offering a blend of history, culture, and natural beauty. Take the evening to explore and have dinner on your own in nearby ByWard Market. (B)

Day 4: Monday, August 2, 2027 Ottawa Today, **it's your choice!** Get to know Ottawa through the lens of one of its renowned museums. Dive into Canada's military past at the War Museum with a veteran's personal story **-OR-** explore the National Gallery's celebrated art collection and create your own masterpiece in a hands-on workshop. During a visit to an Indigenous heritage farm later this afternoon, discover the vibrancy of Indigenous traditions as you experience a Pow Wow dance performance and dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Tuesday, August 3, 2027 Ottawa - Quebec City, Quebec After a full day's drive, say *bonjour* to Quebec City, the heart of Canada's French heritage. Briefly settle into your hotel before heading to Ile d'Orleans, a farmland island on the St. Lawrence River where you'll sample local cuisine for dinner. (B, D)

Day 6: Wednesday, August 4, 2027 Quebec City This morning, enjoy a privately guided tour of the famed Château Frontenac, where history, architecture, and elegance come to life. Then, continue your tour strolling the streets of Old Quebec City (UNESCO) on foot. See the Place Royale and 17th-century buildings, listening to stories of days gone by in historic settings. Your tour ends around noon and the rest of the day is yours to explore the city at leisure. (B)

Day 7: Thursday, August 5, 2027 Quebec City - Montreal Leave Quebec City early this morning for the countryside, where breakfast is served at a local sugar shack. Learn about the traditions of maple syrup-making and enjoy a "lumberjack breakfast" complete with pancakes, baked beans, meat pie, and of course, maple syrup. Before leaving, try a favorite regional treat – maple taffy on the snow! Next, visit the impressive Montmorency Falls and marvel at this natural wonder plunging 272 feet off the Canadian Shield, approximately 100 feet higher than Niagara Falls. Then, sit back and enjoy the ride this afternoon as the journey continues to Montreal. From skyscrapers and cathedrals to rushing waterways and lush gardens, Montreal is a blend of all things old and new. The evening is yours to explore the city independently. (B)

Day 8: Friday, August 6, 2027 Montreal Today, enjoy a panoramic tour of Montreal. Take in the sights of the city, including Jacques Cartier Square and McGill University. Top it off with spectacular views from "the mountain" as it's called by locals, named Mount Royal by Jacques Cartier in 1535. After your guided visit to the renowned Notre-Dame Basilica of Montreal, your tour will end in Old Montreal around lunchtime. The rest of the afternoon is yours to explore the city at leisure. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner celebrating the end of a memorable tour. (B, D)

Day 9: Saturday, August 7, 2027 Montreal - Tour Ends Your tour draws to a close today. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Walking throughout Quebec City and Old Montreal as part of the included features, or on your own, will require navigating cobblestone streets and moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance.

There may be 1 to 2 days on this tour when walking tours can cover 3 to 4 miles over uneven terrain.

The walking tour in Quebec City is approximately 2 hours, covering up to 2 miles, with included breaks.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Due to the long distances covered on this tour, approximately 1000 miles/1609 kilometers, most of our touring days will be full, typically departing for the day by 8:30 a.m. and returning by 5:30 p.m. or later. This means there will also be some long transfer days on the coach, specifically

from Toronto to Ottawa, Ottawa to Quebec City, and Quebec City to Montreal, all of which can have up to 4-5 hours of driving time with included stops along the way.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, baggage fees may apply on most trans-border flights. These fees are levied by each specific airline and may be subject to change.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

A deposit of \$698 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the seat reduction date of January 23, 2027 are based upon availability. Final payment due by May 01, 2027. Deposits are refundable up until January 30, 2027.
