The ECSFCU Mission Statement states "ECSFCU provides financial solutions that are uniquely tailored to our education community ..." A great example of these two statements can be found in ECSFCU's response to a recent California Department of Education (CDE) initiative entitled "Classified School Employee Summer Assistance Program", whereby qualified Classified Employees could pledge to have payroll deductions invested into this plan from Sept 2019 thru June 2020 and the CDE would provide up to a "Dollar-for-Dollar" match in the summer of 2020. Invest \$3,000 (\$300 per month) and receive up to \$6,000 in July/ August 2020.

ECSFCU quickly realized not only the benefit this would be to those that qualified, but more importantly, how difficult it might be to maximize this benefit during the 10-month program.

ECSFCU went to work and developed a "CSESAP" program that will fund the participants up to the amount of their monthly pledge, thereby allowing them to maximize this benefit without a reduction in their monthly payroll.

This program is one of the many reasons why I love what ECSFCU does every day for our hardworking East County School Employees.
