Board Of Directors – Nominations And Elections

Two (2) seats on the ECSFCU Board of Directors will be filled at the next Annual Membership Meeting on Wednesday, February 17, 2021. ECSFCU bylaws require a minimum of two members be nominated for each vacancy. Nominations can also be made by a petition from members. The deadline to submit

nominations and petitions is Friday, November 6, 2020. All nominations must include a signed certificate from the nominee stating that he or she will serve if elected. Printed ballots will be sent to all members in January 2021. Should there only be one nominee for each vacancy, there will NOT be an election by ballot and no nominations from the floor will be accepted at the annual meeting.
