If You Suspect FRAUD on Your Debit Card...

Contact the credit union immediately!

Call our fraud toll-free number 1-888-918-7313 as soon as you are aware or text FRAUD to our main phone number 24/7 and the toll-free number will be sent to you. A fraudulent transaction means that you had no knowledge of who used your card and you were not aware of the transaction. Failure to notify East County Schools FCU within 60 days could mean you will be liable for the entire amount. Notifying us promptly can help prevent additional fraud from occurring. The best way to catch fraud is to monitor your account frequently.





Debit Card Disputes

When you disagree with a merchant about a charge they made to your debit card, this is a cardholder dispute. Examples include when you canceled a transaction, but the merchant still charged you, when a merchant charges you twice for an item, or if a returned item does not get credited.

If you need to dispute a transaction, you must contact the merchant to resolve the issue prior to contacting ECSFCU. Keep all your documentation such as receipts and letters. Unresolved disputes must be reported to us within 60 days of the charges. We will ask you to fill out a dispute form and advocate on your behalf with Visa®.





Meet Nada (pronounced Neh-dah) and Jany

Here's what two of our Member Service Representatives say about working with ECSFCU members.

"Our members get excited to see us when they come in and we're excited to see them too. Because we personally answer our member phone calls, see them in the branch, and we are a small credit union, members know us and we know them. Nada and I know our members' kids and families and they know about ours", said Jany.

"We feel very protective of our members and our members trust us and feel safe here. For example, we know which members might need us to come out to their car because

they can't come in. More than once, we've recognized when something didn't seem 'right' about a member, and prevented fraud from occurring", they shared.

Nada has been with ECS for 7 years and Jany is responsible for our new accounts and has been with the credit union for nearly 9 years. Outside the credit union they both enjoy spending time with their families.
