Employees or retirees who get paid once a month may receive half of each paycheck, 15 days early, up to \$10,000 each month with MyPay15.

**MyPay15 is a Line of Credit. Additional terms and conditions apply and all requests must be approved by the loan department. If advance is not paid back in full on payday due date, balances remaining after the date of payroll posting will incur an interest charge at a rate based on credit rating and as disclosed at the time of account set up. Interest begins accruing at due date.*
