## **Board Of Directors – Nominations And Elections**

Three (3) vacancies on the ECSFCU Board of Directors will be filled at the next annual membership meeting on Tuesday, February 13, 2018. ECSFCU bylaws require a minimum of two members to be nominated for each vacancy. Nominations can also be made by petition from members.

The deadline to submit nominations and petitions is Friday, November 10, 2017. All nominations must include a signed certificate from the nominee stating that he or she will serve if elected. Printed ballots will be sent to all members in January 2018. Should there only be one nominee for each vacancy, there will NOT be an election by ballot and no nominations from the floor will be accepted at the annual meeting.
