Area XI, Division 69, East County, San Diego, California Retired Teachers Association pledges two (2) \$1,500 scholarships **for the 2022 – 2023** school year.

This application, when completed and saved, should be emailed to scholarshipdiv69@gmail.com

When using a mobile device, the application must be saved before it can be completed.

Letters of recommendation and proof of enrollment in the teacher training program should be scanned into a single PDF and emailed to scholarshipdiv69@gmail.com. A copy of the transcript from the university where you received your undergraduate degree and a copy of the transcript where you are currently enrolled should also be included in this one PDF. This facilitates the review process.

Restriction:

Scholarship money is to be used for tuition and/or books and supplies during student-teaching semesters. Applicants who have already completed student teaching, or who will not be doing student teaching during the year of the scholarship, are not eligible.

Qualifications:

The applicant must have a Bachelor's Degree, be enrolled in the teacher training program of a college/university in San Diego County, be a resident of San Diego County, be pursuing a California teaching credential and student teach between July 2022 – June 2023.

Dates to place in your calendar:

The application, with all supporting documents, must be **received** no later than **Monday, April 18, 2022.** Finalists will be contacted for a personal interview to be held in early May.

Scholarship recipients will be notified after all interviews are completed. Funds will be sent to the university where the applicant is enrolled, no earlier than the Summer term of 2022.

The winners of the award will be introduced to the membership of CalRTA Division 69 at a Fall meeting in 2022. Winners will be asked to give a two minute talk to the membership at that meeting.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the scholarship application and personal essay. (DO NOT SEND RESUMÉS.)
2. **In addition**, email the following items to: scholarshipdiv69@gmail.com
 - **Two** letters of recommendation, at least **one** of which is to be written specifically for this scholarship, from people who know you well (for example, a teacher, minister, employer, etc.). At least one letter must be from a professional educator who knows you well. Letters from relatives or friends are not acceptable.
 - If possible, proof of enrollment in the teacher-training program of your college/university. If school deadlines make the final proof impossible, include a note from the program coordinator stating when your acceptance will be finalized.
 - Copies of the two required transcripts. Refer to page one of the directions.

Late applications (after the April 18 deadline) will NOT be accepted.
